Engineer selected for dam project

LULING — Luling City Council named TRC Engineering as the engineers of record for the Bank Reclamation FEMA project during its March 13 meeting. City Manager Mark Mayo said proposals were received by TRC Engineering and BEFCO Engineering for the Zedler Mill Bank Reclamation FEMA project. Mayo recommended choosing TRC as they have been working on the project and already familiar with it. The board awarded engineering services to TRC Engineering specifically for the FEMA Bank Reclamation project based on Mayo's recommendation and their current involvement in the work. In his monthly Police Activity Report, Chief Sala said Sergeant Martinez resigned effective last Friday. He also said the new police vehicle, replacing the one totaled during last month's storm, will go into service tonight, and the last of the video equipment is installed. Councilman Wells offered his appreciation of the two new animal control officers, and said they were doing an excellent job. Chief Sala agreed. The board approved or adopted the following agenda items: the budget for the ensuing fiscal year beginning April 1, 2014, and the resolution regarding a proposed Property Tax Abatement Agreement for the abatement of taxes for the new La Quinta Hotel.
