Three suspects in custody after shooting report

Shots fired near local schools caused some anxious moments while the police located the suspects on Monday afternoon.

Captain Allen Taylor reported on Monday at around 2:48 p.m. Officer Trey Tunis was dispatched to the area of Robertson and School Streets in reference to shots being fired.

Officers located and stopped a vehicle that was seen leaving the area of the shots being fired. Based on investigation of that traffic stop, three individuals were taken into custody.

German Corpus, 18, of Luling, was charged with possession of a controlled substance, tampering with identification number, and unlawful use of criminal instrument or mechanical security device.

Malcom Oshea Houston, 22, of Lockhart, was also charged with same charges with an additional charge of felon in possession of firearm.

A 16-year-old male from Luling was charged with possession of a controlled substance, unlawfully carrying a weapon, tampering with identification number, and possession of marijuana. A weapon along with narcotics was located in the vehicle.

The two adults were transported to the Gonzales County Sheriff's Office. The juvenile was transported to the Guadalupe County Juvenile Detention Center in Seguin.

School officials were given the "all clear" to release the children from the nearby Gonzales Elementary and East Avenue Primary schools at around 3:15 p.m.
